



Splash Kingdom Family Waterpark and Party Castle 2008 Code of Conduct

"...conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ..." - Philippians 1:27

Splash Kingdom's mission is to glorify God while providing a safe and fun recreational experience for families. The following Code of Conduct has been established to assist in achieving this goal. Thank you in advance for abiding by the following:

1. All guests are required to pay the admission price or have a current season pass.
2. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible guardian.
3. Guests may be denied admission to the park for the following:
 - a. Suspicion of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs
 - b. Evidence of a contagious disease
 - c. Evidence of open wounds
 - d. Inappropriate swim attire
4. Conservative swimwear only. No thongs, "Speedos", or swim attire made of see-through material when wet or dry will be allowed.
5. Denim shorts or clothing with plastic or metal rivets that may damage slide surfaces are prohibited.
6. Swim diapers are required for those two years and under for the safety of our guests. Regular diapers are prohibited in the water. Swim diapers can be purchased at our retail shop.
7. Abusive or profane language of any kind will not be tolerated. Any guest exhibiting this behavior may be escorted out of the park.
8. Smoking, chewing tobacco, alcoholic beverages, lighters, and illegal substances are not allowed on the park property.
9. Horseplay of any kind is prohibited. This includes dunking, riding on shoulders, fighting, rough play, pushing and shoving, stunts, unruly behavior, running, excessive splashing, and towel popping.
10. No diving of any type will be permitted.
11. Only animals needed for medical reasons will be permitted in the pool area.
12. Guests are not allowed in the office, filter areas, mechanical rooms, or storage areas. Guests are not allowed to use the office phone.
13. Guests are not allowed to sit or hang on the Lifeguard stations. Talking to a Lifeguard is permitted only if there is an emergency or if immediate assistance is needed. Our Guest Services staff will happily address all other guest questions or concerns.
14. There will be no loitering in or around Splash Kingdom, including the parking lot.



15. Water toys and outside floatation devices other than Coast Guard approved life jackets are not permitted. All floatation devices used in the park have been selected for both the comfort and safety of our guests and are available free of charge on a first come, first served basis.

16. Some of our attractions require a minimum height of 48". If you have a history of medical problems such as brittle bones, surgery, neck or back problems, or if you are pregnant; these rides are not recommended.

17. Picnic facilities are available in areas around the parking lot. These areas are nonsmoking. Please limit your use of these facilities to 30 minutes. Personal food and beverages will not be allowed in the park.

18. All tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. This includes inclement weather and power outages.

19. All guests are expected to obey the rules and regulations listed above and follow any additional instructions given by the Splash Kingdom Water Safety Team and/or Park employees.

20. Splash Kingdom reserves the right to escort any guest from the Park property and suspend visitation privileges for violation of these rules or any other action detrimental to the safe and orderly operation of the Park. Serious violators or trespassers may be subject to arrest by the Canton Police Department. Splash Kingdom's Code of Conduct is not intended to be all inclusive and serves as a guideline for acceptable Park behavior.
